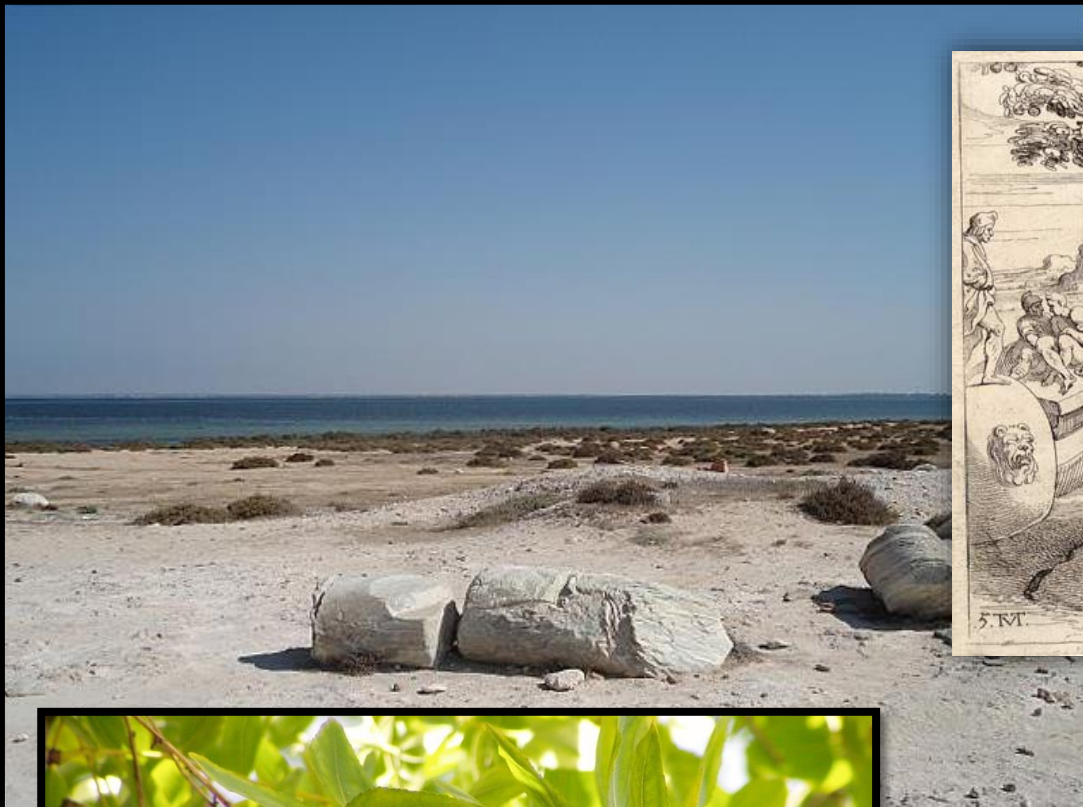

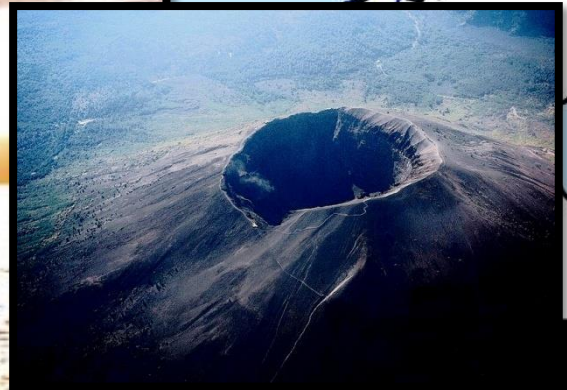

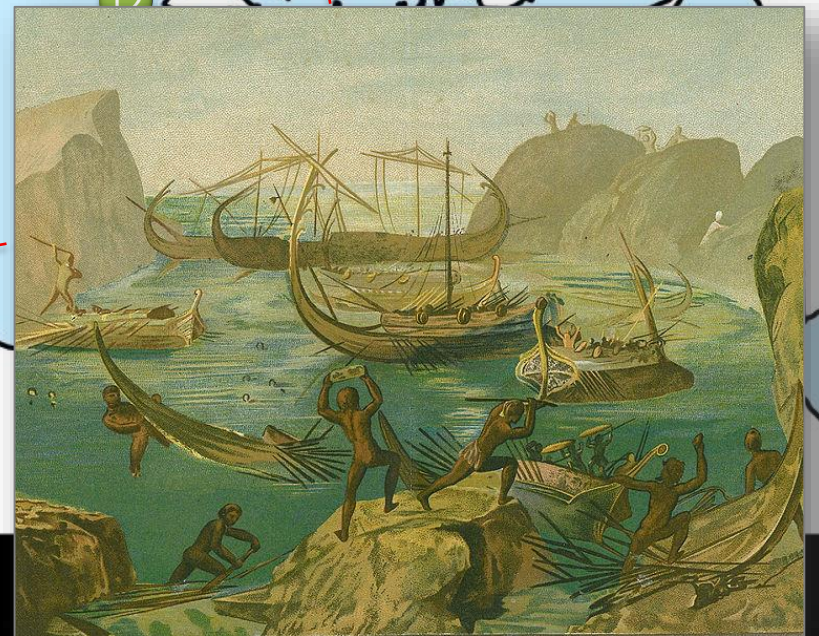
1. *Ulysse et ses compagnons aveuglant le Cyclope* (560 avant J.C.)

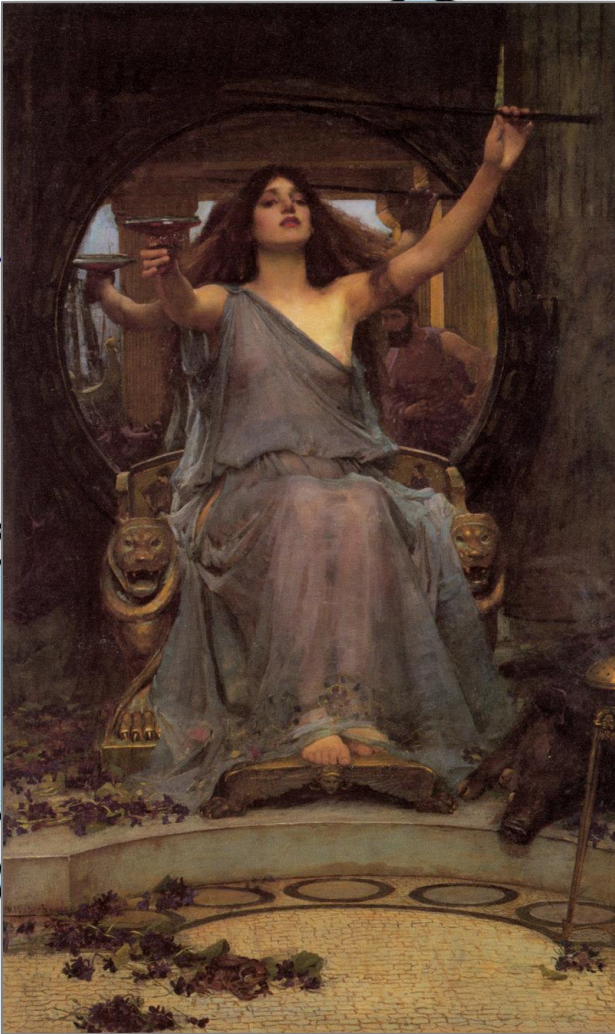

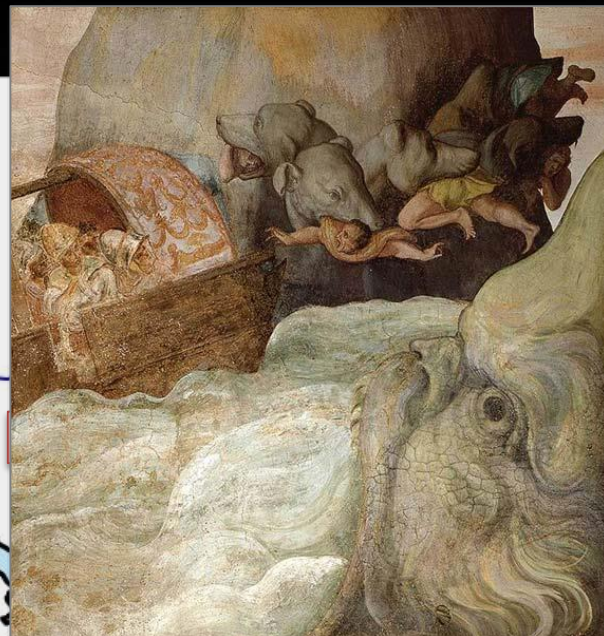
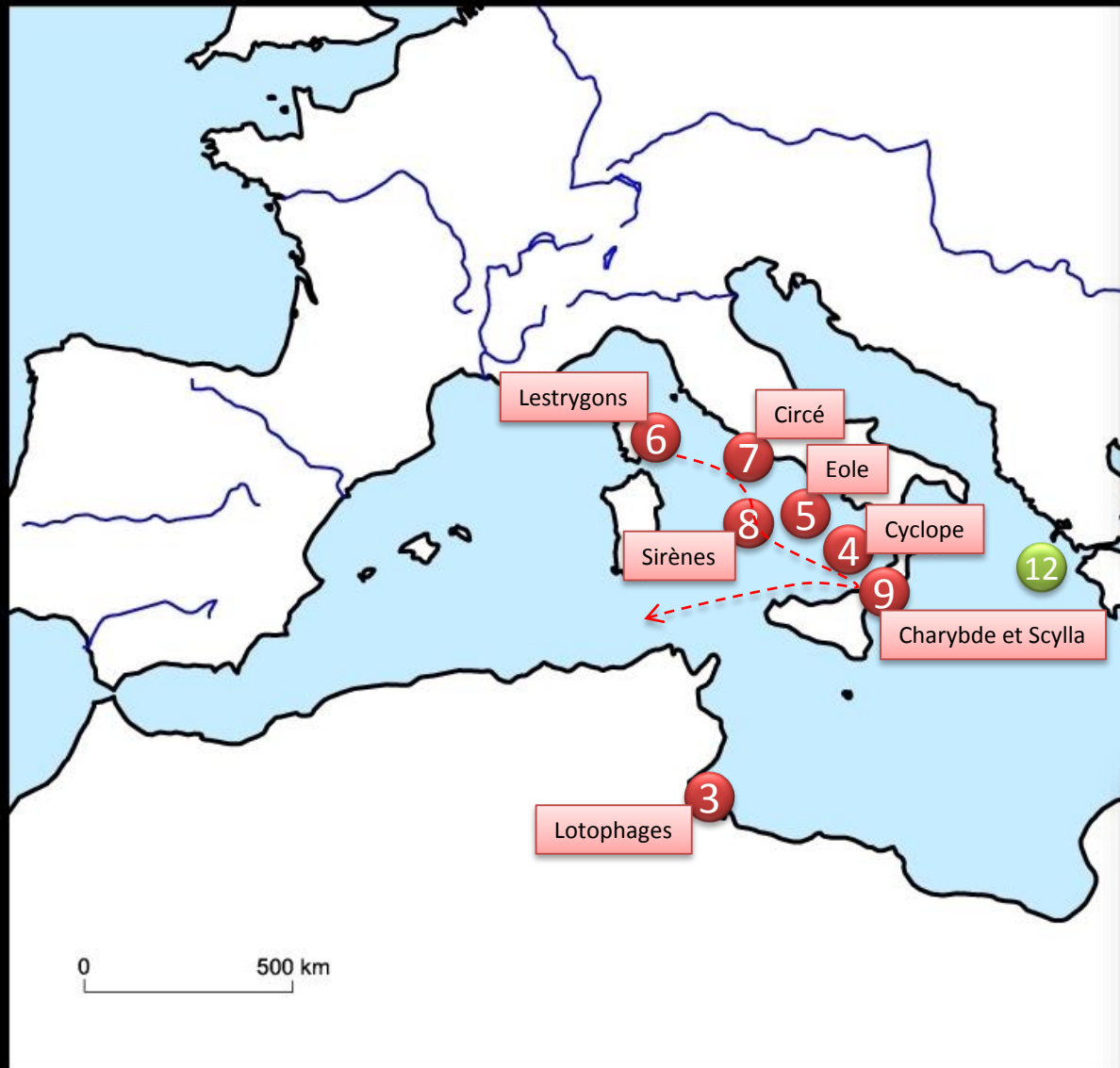


1. Stamnos attique à figures rouges

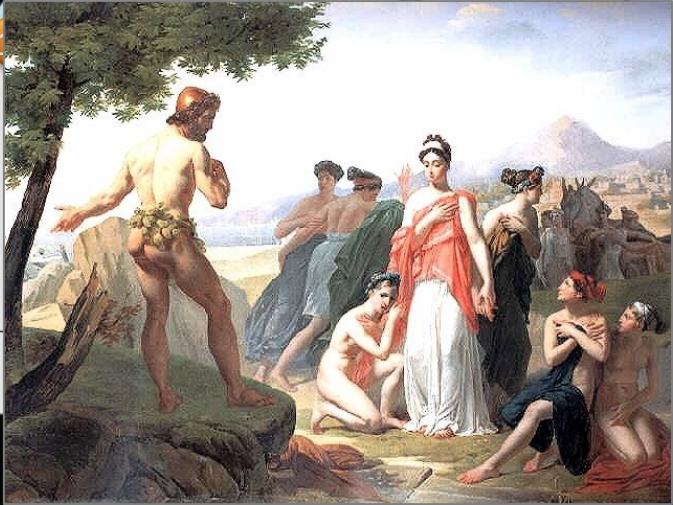
2. Mosaique romaine (IIe s.)
